



CPST Recertification Requirements

CPS certification expires after two years. Technicians and Instructors are required to complete the recertification process before current certification expires. To recertify:

- **Set-up your online profile** (cert.safekids.org/log). Contact Safe Kids Worldwide at (202) 875-6330 or CPScert@safekids.org for assistance. This online system is for Certified Technicians, Instructors, and people who are interested in becoming CPS-certified. Once you login to the Certification Management system this will allow you to:
 - Register for a course (Certification or Renewal)
 - Recertify: Enter your seat checks, CEUs, etc.
 - Apply to be an instructor or tech proxy
- **Login Information**
Go to the cert.safekids.org/log and click log in. Then click forgot password, enter the requested information and you will be sent an email to change your password.
 - Username: Email address you used to register for the course
- **Make contact with your local certified CPS instructor(s).** It is up to you to connect with an instructor to have your seat checks verified. You can do this by going to cert.safekids.org/log and clicking "Find a tech/ instructor."
- **Complete these requirements and record the activities in your online profile:**
 - Conduct all [five different types of seat checks](#)
 - Participate in at least [one community education event](#) (checkups, community workshop, educational session)
 - Participate in at least [six continuing education units](#) (CEUs)
 - [CEU options](#)
- **Pay the recertification fee.** The recertification fee is \$55 for technicians and instructor candidates and \$60 for instructors. Recertification fee scholarships are available, see eligibility requirements by going to safekidswi.org/technician and clicking "Re-certification Information."

You must complete all recertification requirements, including paying the recertification fee, on or before the expiration date of your current certification.
